The following instructions have been prepared to assist you in completing the admissions application process and expediting a decision on your application. Please be sure to indicate the semester and academic year for which you are applying.

Carefully review the entire application before you begin to write. You will be required to tell us your entrance category. Students applying as first-time freshmen will be given the opportunity to apply during the Early or Regular Action processes. All first-time freshmen applying for Early Action period must have a completed application packet postmarked on or before November 1st. For Regular Action applicants, application packets must be postmarked by March 1st and November 1st deadline for the spring semester.

Failure to meet the application deadline may delay the processing of your application for the semester you wish to be considered.

The admissions committee will review no application before the entire application packet is complete.

The Application Fee is \$50.00. Payments must be made with certified checks or money orders. First-time freshmen also should submit an official high school transcript and SAT I or ACT scores. Morehouse College uses the SAT II Writing scores and the SAT II Mathematics IIc scores in order to place first year students into college classes. While these scores are not used to decide admission, all new students must submit these scores prior to enrollment at Morehouse College. The deadline for applications is March 1 for fall admission and November 1 for spring admission. Transfer students are required to have a 2.50 or better cumulative college grade point average. A minimum of 26 semester hours (39 quarter hours) of college credit earned must be presented for admission. A maximum of 60 semester hours (90 quarter hours) may be transferred to Morehouse College. An interview may be a part of the admission procedure. You will be contacted by the college if an interview is necessary.
